Carbon Leakage – Options for the EU post 2020

MEP Bogusław Sonik and CEPS are organizing a Workshop in the European Parliament to launch the report entitled “**Carbon leakage: Options for the EU post 2020**”, recently published by **Centre for European Policy Studies (CEPS)**.
